READING

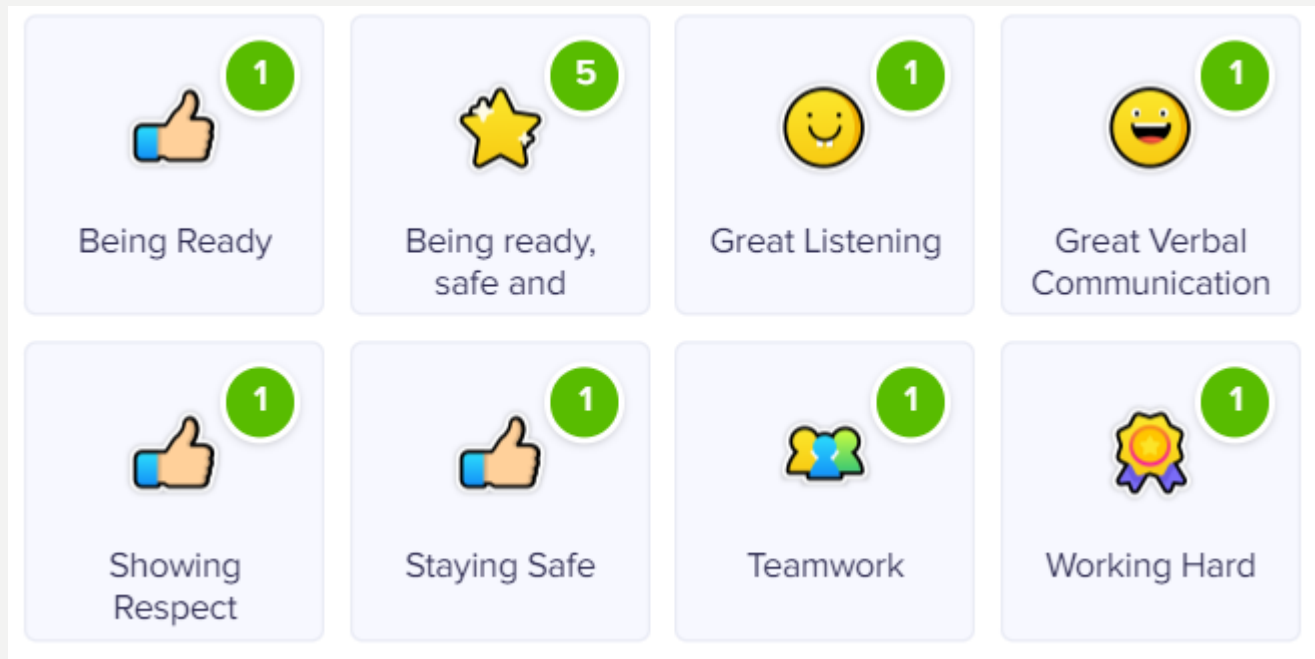
- Please sign their reading records so we can see that they are reading at home.

- As children become more fluent and confident with their reading, we can start to build on their comprehension skills by asking questions about the texts/books they have read.

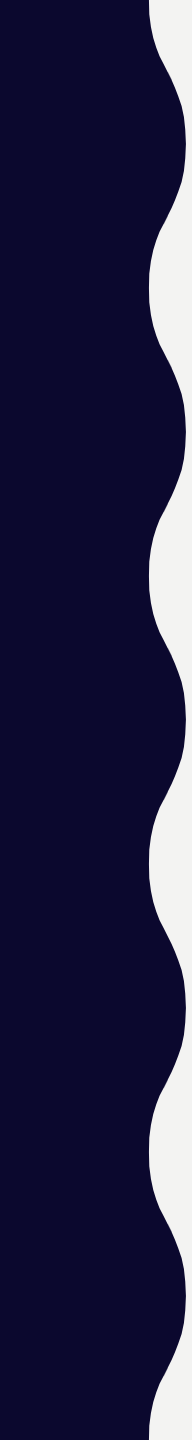
HOMework
