How will homework be organised in Class 3?

Homework will be set weekly in Class 3. The homework activities will reflect the learning that is taking place in class each week. The homework will be set to extend the children's learning and understanding of the focused topics.

How will reading be organised in Class 3?

The expectation is for all children to be reading at home daily and to have their reading diaries signed after they have been listened to. Inside their reading diaries will be a list of key ideas that you can try out at home with your child. These key ideas encourage the children to make inferences and deductions about the text they are reading, developing their comprehension. All of these expectations will continue in the classroom so the children need to bring their reading book and reading diaries into school everyday. Our classroom will also have a cosy reading corner with a wide selection of reading books for your children to choose from.

How will timetables be organised in Class 3?

Children will be expected to practice their timetables through Times Tables Rockstars at home. Each week, there will be a times tables quiz in class. These quizzes will be used to help the children identify what times tables they need to practice and what times tables they are confident with.

How will spellings be organised in Class 3?

A spelling quiz will take place once a week in class. The spelling words will be sent home each week so the children have a one week to practice before the quiz. Words from the Curriculum Spelling Lists for Years 3 and 4 will be included in the quizzes.
