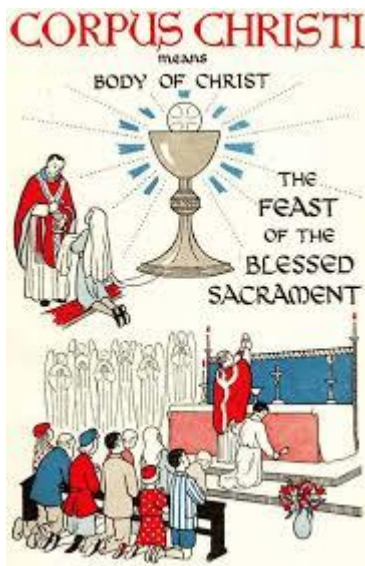




Dear parents, family members and friends of St Joseph's,
